Behavior Expectations of Campers

We expect Camp Sunshine Dreams to be the very best camp possible. Our hope is that camp will be a place where campers can make friends and find support. To ensure that camp is safe, fun, and enjoyable for everyone, there are important expectations that must be discussed before campers arrive.

Please read and discuss this letter carefully. Afterward, sign it and return it with your camp forms.

EXPECTATIONS:

1. Each camper must treat all individuals at camp with respect and consideration. Camp will not tolerate intimidation, verbal or physical abuse, or destruction of property.
2. Camp is an experience in group living. For camp to run successfully, all campers are expected to cooperate and help with daily chores (including cabin clean-up, packing and unloading, dining hall set-up and clean-up) and to follow cabin rules.
3. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, smoking or vaping devices, fireworks, guns, knives, slingshots, or any other weapons are strictly prohibited at camp.
4. Physically abusive, sexual, or sexually suggestive behavior will not be tolerated.
5. Campers are expected to be respectful and responsible at all times, including during off-site trips, outings, and camp visitor days.
6. Cussing, swearing, and the use of foul or inappropriate language are not acceptable at camp.

If at any time these expectations are violated, or if the Camp Director determines that a camper's behavior negatively affects the camp experience, the parent(s) or guardian will be notified and required to pick up their child immediately at their own expense. The Camp Board of Directors will determine whether an expelled camper may return to camp in the future.
